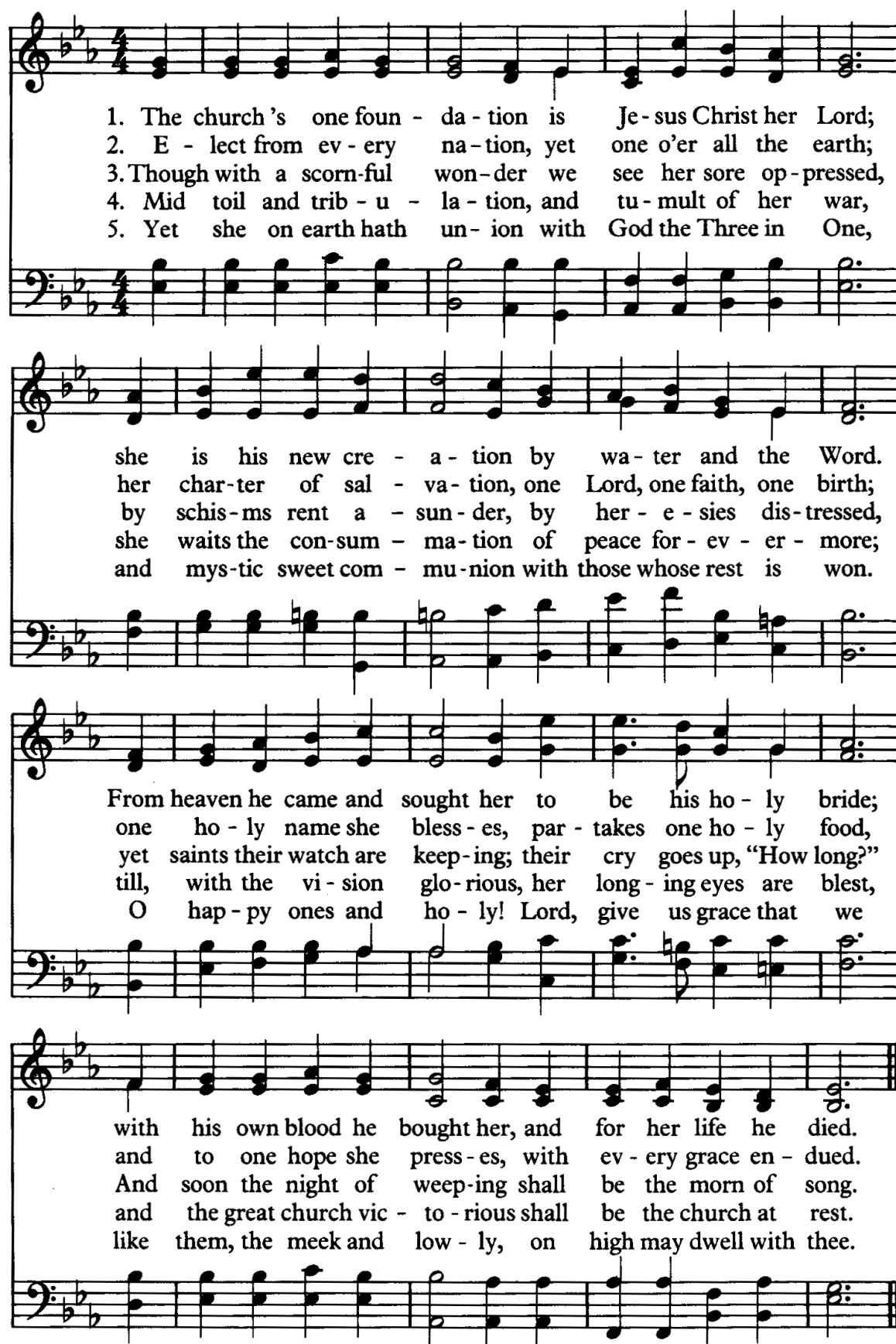

 Come, love of Christ, a - fresh to win us;

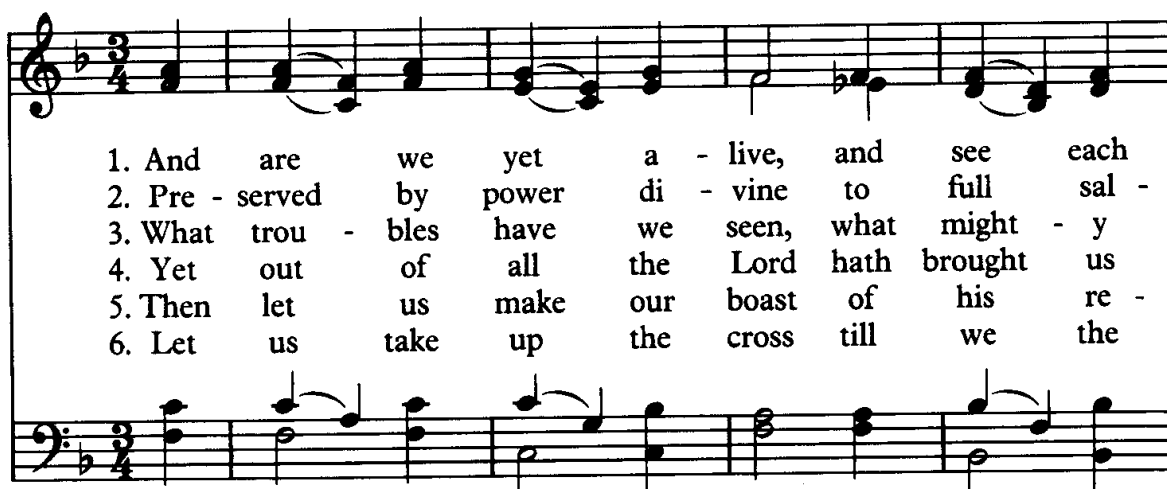
and fit your church to meet this hour.

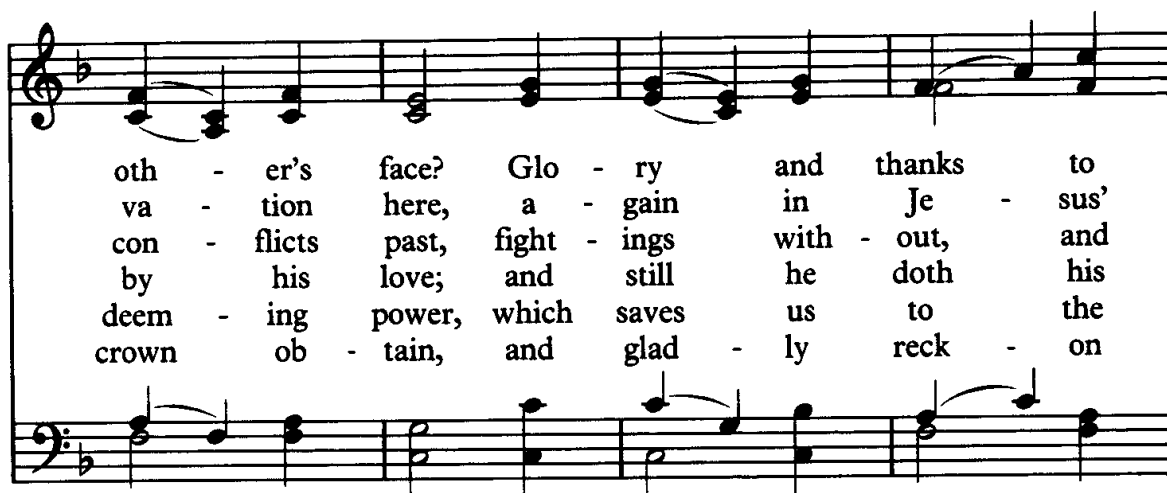
